About InDIRECT

InDIRECT is a European applied research project that is exploring new value chains based on underspent organic side streams. One of the objectives is the development of indirect cascading biorefinery processes for converting a variety of underspent side streams into useful marketable products. As a first step in the biorefinery, insects are used for the homogenisation of thesides treams. In a next step the insect biomass is fractionated into crude extracts, which are purified and converted in a last step. The biorefinery processes are being optimized to increase the conversion efficiency (product/ton biomass input) and maximize the values of the feedstock (euro/ton biomass input). Further, different application areas like feed, chemistry and food are being explored for the extracted compounds. The project takes into account the whole value chain and the associated economic, environmental, legal and practical aspects and lab to pilot.

InDIRECT contributes to 'management of waste as a resource' and intends to accelerate innovation and market uptake of bio-based products.
